Senior High Camp: July 7-13 (Directors Katie Hensley, Joel Pistello, and Dale Ward)

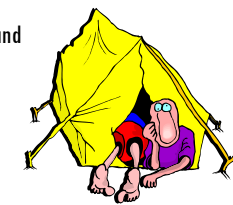
Cost: *\$142.50 per person (if registration is received by June 21) - fee increases by \$50 per person after this date

Request for rooms in the Lodge are anticipated to exceed the number of rooms available. Preference in assignment will be given in the following "priority basis" -

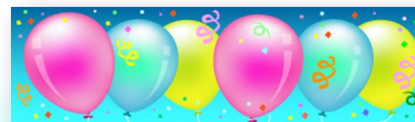
1. Guest ministry and Reunion leadership
