The Mission Center is providing \$275 scholarships, which can be applied to 2026 Sr. High Camp or SPEC or other mission center youth activities, for Sr. Highs selected to serve on the KP Crew at Reunion. Additionally, these workers are allowed to attend the reunion for free. These kitchen crews will work at the **PBMC Reunion (beginning at 4PM June 27 – 11AM on July 2, 2026)** -- washing dishes, pots & pans, cleaning tables, sweeping/mopping floors, emptying trash, etc. Sr. Highs will need to attend with a parent or recruit their own “Sponsor” over the age of 21 for the week of the Reunion (being “housed” in the same housing as the parent or adult sponsor).

Eligibility:

- Resident of Prairie Bluffs Mission Center.
- Entering 10th grade in the Fall of 2026, through a 2026 graduate.
- Ability to “carry through” with the responsibilities and duties.
- Must attend Sr. High class and evening service each day.
- Must be in their cabin no later than midnight each night.
- Complete and submit application by May 15, 2026.
